COMMUNITY BUILDING PROGRAM

providing church and community organizations training and technical assistance to identify, design, finance, and manage infrastructural initiatives such as housing, bridges, schools, and roads.

127 permanent homes were built in **9** different hamlets of el tinteral, part of **ENLACE'S** continuing response to the **2001** earthquakes. **2** churches and **3** community associations managed the selection and construction process of the homes.

6 short-term medical teams provided 3,286 people in 12 hamlets with medical attention and medicines.

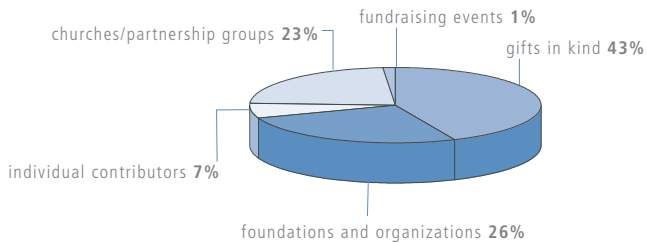

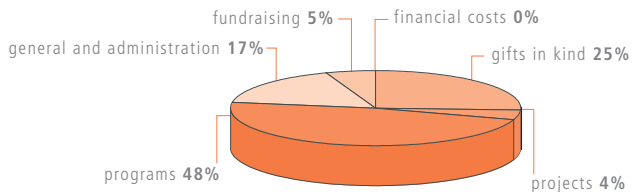
