THE EQUIPPING PROCESS: INTERESTED, COMMITTED, LEADER

ENLACE commits to a 10 year relationship with a local church in el salvador. we equip the church leaders to become effective agents of change as they understand who they are as a body, listen to their community and respond to opportunities for developing sustainable solutions for poverty. our long-term goal is that churches become leaders that equip surrounding churches. we can roughly define churches as going through the process of being “interested,” then “committed” and eventually “leaders” in their community. churches become leaders when they embody the following values:

SERVANT LEADERSHIP

Commitment to listen, collaborate, trust and empower

INTEGRAL MISSION

A church community that incarnates god's love through sacrificial service to its neighbors

SUSTAINABLE SOLUTIONS

Projects and programs maximize existing resources to build enduring solutions to poverty

EFFECTIVE COLLABORATION

Partner with their community to identify, design and manage sustainable initiatives

REPLICABLE MODELS

Church leaders equip new churches to transform their communities

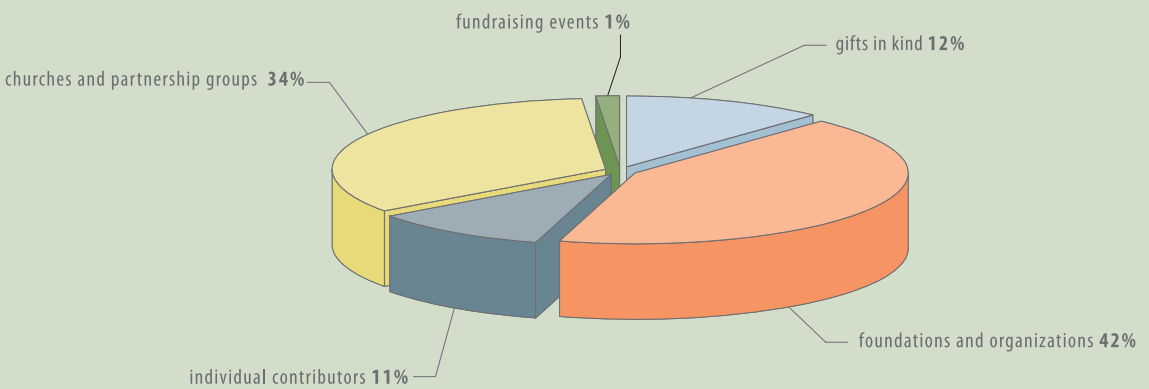

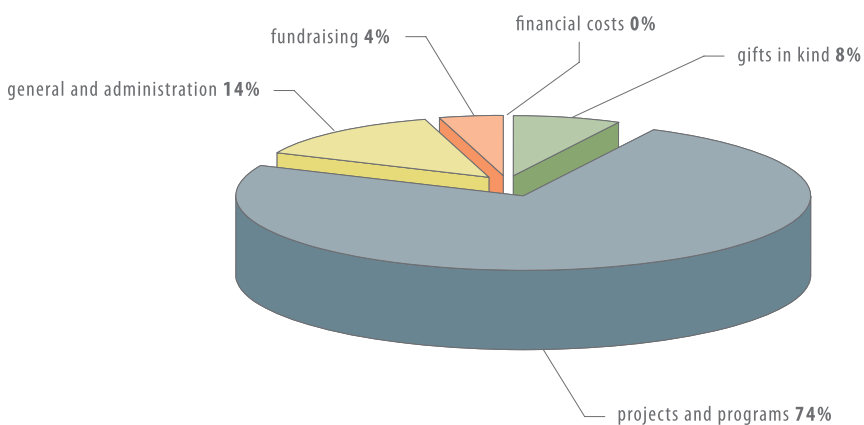
